5. No weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every tongue that rises up against me in judgment shall be condemned (Isaiah 54:17).
6. I love God with all my heart, soul, and mind (Mark 12:30).
7. I love my neighbor as myself (Mark 12:31).
8. I am the temple of the Living God (II Corinthians 6:16).
9. I am faithful over a few things, and I will be made ruler over many (Matthew 25:23).
10. I submit to God, I resist the devil, and he must flee from me (James 4:7).
11. Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world (1 John 4:4).
12. I am like a tree planted by the rivers of water, and I bring forth fruit in my season. My leaf does not wither and whatever I do prosper (Psalm 1:3).
13. My heart keeps the commandments of God, and length of days, long life, and peace shall they add to me (Proverbs 3:1,2).

20. I am taught of God's ways, and I walk in his paths (Isaiah 2:3).
21. I know that the Son of God is come and hath given me an understanding that I may know him that is true (1 John 5:20).
22. Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden part You shall make me to know wisdom (Psalm 51:6).
23. I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ (Romans 1:16).
24. I desire the sincere milk of The Word that I may grow thereby (I Peter 2:2).
25. Faith, Hope, and Love (especially love) abide in me (I Corinthians 13:13).
26. I am the seed of Abraham, and just like him, God has counted me righteous (Genesis 15:6).
27. I am meek, and I inherit the earth (Matthew 5:5).
28. I will pray for all those in authority over me that I may lead a quiet and peaceful life in all godliness and honesty (I Timothy 2:2).
29. I have been given the power to become a child of God (John 1: 12).
30. I seek first the Kingdom and God's righteousness, and all things are added unto me (Matthew 6:33).
31. I am a true worshipper, one who worships in spirit and in truth (John 4:23).
32. I do not live off of bread alone but of every word that proceeds from the mouth of God (Deuteronomy 8:3).
33. Out of my belly flow rivers of living water (John 7:37).
34. I have been chosen by God to bring forth fruit that shall remain (John 15:16).
35. I am a brand new person inside, pure and holy, full of God's goodness (II Corinthians 5:17; I Corinthians 1:30, II Corinthians 5:21).

36. My sins have been taken away, and I am forgiven. I am now chosen, adopted, and forgiven with every spiritual blessing in heavenly places (Ephesians 1:7; Ephesians 1:3).
37. I am free from sickness. I believe in my heart that Jesus' wounds heal me. I can lay my hands on the sick, and they will recover (I Peter 2:24; Mark 16:18).
38. I have everything because I have Christ, and I am filled with God (Colossians 2:10).
39. Whatever I ask for in prayer, I believe that I have received it (Mark 11:24).
40. I am part of a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, and a holy nation. I am one of God's own people (1 Peter 2:9).
41. I am not fearful because God has given me a spirit of power, love, and self-control (2 Timothy 1:7).
42. I am a citizen of God's Kingdom and a member of His household (Ephesians 2:19).
43. In Christ, I was chosen before the world was made. In His love, He chose me to be a holy person and without blame before Him (Ephesians 1:4).
44. I trust and believe in Christ, and I have been sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, the deposit of my inheritance (Ephesians 1:13).
45. In Christ Jesus, I have been made a new person that I may do the good works He has planned for me (Ephesians 2:10).
46. I, therefore, having been justified by faith, have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ (Roman5: 1).
47. I am dead to the power of sin and have been made alive with God through Christ Jesus (Romans 6:11).
48. I have redemption through His blood and the forgiveness of sins according to the riches of His grace (Ephesians 1:7).
49. I have been raised with Christ, and I sit with Him in the heavenly places (Ephesians 2:6).
50. I am the light of the world. I am like a city on top of a hill that cannot be hidden (Matthew 5:14).
51. I shall not be afraid because the Lord is my light, my salvation, and the strength of my life (Psalm 27:1).
52. I am as bold as a lion because Jesus has made me the righteous of God (Proverbs 28:1).
