Scripture Reading:

Psalm 95:1-7, John 16:5-15

Reflections of the Heart:

Scriptural Prayer:

The eyes of all look to You in hope; You give them their food as they need it. When You open Your hand, You satisfy the hunger and thirst of every living thing. We bless and praise Your holy Name!

Almighty Father, we declare that Your Word will be operative in the lives of our business leaders and in the economic development of our city. Father, we confess that our business leaders are blessed and we expect favor to surround them like a shield. We confess that as our business leaders commit their works to You, their plans will succeed. We proclaim that the Christian business leaders in our city will seek Your Kingdom above all else, and live righteously, and You will give them everything they need for their business. We declare that they will honor You with their wealth and with the best part of everything they produce, then their barns will be filled with grain and their vats will overflow with good wine. Lord, we confess that as our business leaders walk uprightly and do what is right, no good thing will be withheld from them. Holy Spirit, show me which business to pray for this month:

Merciful Father, forgive our business leaders for all acts of sinfulness. Forgive those who have not been diligent in seeking Your leadership for their business. Forgive those who have not treated employees and customers fairly. Forgive those Christian business owners who have not been faithful in giving their tithes and offerings. Forgive those who have not properly taken care of or shown respect for the community they live in. Forgive me for not supporting those businesses You have established in my community. Lord, forgive me for **(list any sins that you have committed)**. Holy Spirit, remind our business leaders of those they need to forgive and help them to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)."*** ***Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Caring Father, help our business leaders to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Sovereign Lord, You are the King of glory. You are the Lord, strong and mighty; the Lord invincible in battle. You are the King of Glory, the Lord of Heaven's Armies is Your Name! In Jesus' Name, Amen.
