Prayer Petition #13:

A Prayer for Persons Diagnosed with Cancer

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 110, Psalm 91

Reflections of the Heart:

In recent years, too many people have been diagnosed with cancer. For many, this diagnosis creates fear and sometimes hopelessness. For every cancer patient, there is hope. Supernatural healing is as real today as it was in the Book of Acts. By Jesus' stripes healing has been provided. Today, when you pray this prayer, pray in faith and confidence knowing that your words will produce a favorable prognosis.

Scriptural Prayer:

Heavenly Father, we proclaim Your righteousness and praise all the day long. Your Truth endures forever and Your compassion does not fail. Great is Your faithfulness. Who can compare to You? We exalt Your Holy and Righteous Name. You are the Holy One of Israel who sent Jesus, our Lord and Savior, to redeem all mankind from the curse of the law of sin and death. Lord, we thank You for watching over those persons who have been diagnosed with cancer. Thank You for Your healing power. Thank You, Lord, for declaring us overcomers by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of our testimony.

Father, Your thoughts towards us are of peace and not evil, to give us a future and a hope. We believe that it is Your will that we live free from all diseases. Lord, by the authority given to us, we declare that the infirmity of cancer with its many forms and common types; bladder, breast, colon and rectal, endometrial, leukemia, lung, melanoma, pancreatic, prostrate, skin, thyroid and other types are destroyed, in Jesus name. We command the primary abnormal deformed cell to die at its root and the metastasizing cells to cease from spreading throughout the body, especially to the lungs, bones, liver and brain.
