

Prayer Topic #8:

A Prayer for the Girls in The Body of Christ

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 48:9-11, Proverbs 3:5-6

Scriptural Prayer:

Heavenly Father, we thank You, for blessing our girls in the Body of Christ. Thank You for creating them in Your image and filling them with Your love. Thank You, Holy Spirit, for helping our girls to know their worth and value in You. You are our God and there is no other. We worship You in the beauty of Your Holiness. You are the true and living God to whom all honor and glory belongs. We will love You, Lord, our strength. You are our rock, our fortress and Savior. You are our shield, our place of safety.

Magnificent Father, today, we declare that the girls in the Body of Christ will not copy the behavior and customs of this world, but they will be transformed by the Holy Spirit to do what is good and pleasing and perfect in Your sight. We confess that they are blessed and they will flourish like palm trees and be as strong as the cedars of Lebanon. We decree that our girls will excel in their studies, sports and club activities. They are the head and not the tail. We declare that every girl in the Body of Christ will graduate from high school and college and will be happy, holy, productive members of our society. Above all, we confess that our girls have victorious futures because Your plans for them are of hope; filled with good and not evil.

Holy Spirit, please touch the hearts of the Body of Christ to always pray for our girls. Empower them to be good daughters, cousins, aunts and friends. Touch the hearts of their moms and dads to raise our girls to be excellent leaders, wives and mothers. Help each girl in the Body of Christ to grow in Your wisdom and stature like Jesus. Help them to stay out of trouble and to choose friends who love Christ and will encourage them to make good choices.

Holy Spirit, I will pray for (list the names of girls that you know at church):

Gracious Father, please forgive our girls for all of their sins. Forgive them for disobedience, rebellion and bad conduct. Forgive those girls who don't bring You glory by the way they treat themselves and others. Forgive the mean girls and help them to stop being mean to others. Father, forgive me for **(list any sins that you have committed.)** Holy Spirit, remind our girls of those they need to forgive and help them to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s).")***

Holy Spirit, help the girls in the Body of Christ to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Almighty Lord, may You be praised forever and ever. Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power, the glory, the victory and the majesty. Everything in the heavens and on earth is Yours. Lord, this is Your Kingdom. Wealth and honor come from You alone, and You rule over everything. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
