

Prayer Topic #4:

A Prayer for the Ministries of Our Windsor Village Church Family

Scripture Reading:

Psalms 95:1-7, I Corinthians 12:12-31

Reflections of the Heart:

As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person (s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Holy Spirit, help our ministry members to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Eternal King, the heavens declare Your glory and the skies proclaim the work of Your hands. You are the Lord Most High, the great King over all the earth. Lord, You are worthy to receive glory, honor, and power. You created all things and by Your will they exist and were created. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
