Prayer Topic #1:

A Prayer of Healing During Cold and Flu Season

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 86:11-13, James 5:13-16

Scriptural Prayer:

(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)."
