## A Prayer of Healing for Healthcare Professionals

## Scripture Reading:

Psalms 93, John 5:1-11

## Reflections of the Heart:

## **ONE Prayer**:

Glorious Father, we thank You for Your eternal love and unmerited grace for healthcare professionals. Thank You for sending Your Son, Jesus, to bring hope and healing to them. They give thanks because You are near. Healthcare professionals everywhere will tell of Your wonderful deeds. Lord, You are good and Your unfailing love endures forever. You alone are God. How great are Your signs and how powerful are Your wonders. Lord, You are high above all the nations. Your glory is higher than the heavens. Who can be compared with You, our God, who is enthroned on high.

Awesome Father, we expect You to display Your glory in their lives when they are in need of healing. With You, nothing is impossible. We expect their diseases to be dissolved, broken relationships to be mended and minds and souls to be set free. As we pray for those in need of healing, we confess that Your healing power will operate through them. By faith, we declare that they will pay attention to Your Word and listen carefully to it. They will not lose sight of it. They will let it penetrate deep into their hearts. As they do this, Your Word will bring life and healing to their whole bodies.

List the names of healthcare professionals you know who need healing. Speak their names by saying, "in Jesus Name, we declare healing for (<u>say their names</u>)." Righteous Father, please help healthcare professionals to be bolder about praying for healing. Help them to be freed from renegade blood cells, heart disease, stroke, kidney disease, all types of cancers, aneurysms, mental illness, stress, insomnia, obesity and lack of attention to their overall health and well-being. Show them how to trust in You with all their hearts and not depend on their own understanding. Righteous Father, please open their eyes so that they will understand the confident hope given to those Christ has called. Remind them to look to You for help and strength. Allow them to be an example of good eating habits, exercise, regular checkups and faithfulness to You, Lord. Father, cause Your healing power to be experienced throughout their lives.

Merciful Father, forgive healthcare professionals for all acts of sinfulness. Forgive those who act Godly, but deny Your power to perform healings, signs and wonders in their lives and in the lives of others. Lord, please forgive and restore to them the joy of Your salvation. Lord, forgive me for (*list any sins that you have committed*). Holy Spirit, remind healthcare professionals of those they need to forgive and help them to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. (*Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)* 

Holy Spirit, help healthcare professionals not to yield to temptation but deliver them from the evil one.

Royal Lord, You are the Almighty! Only You can open the eyes of the blind and unplug the ears of the deaf. You cause the lame to leap like deer and those who cannot speak to sing for joy. You cause springs to gush forth in the wilderness and streams to water the wasteland. You cause the parched ground to become a pool and springs of water to satisfy the thirsty land. Great and awesome is Your Name. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
