A Prayer Regarding Our Healthcare

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 46, Psalm 91

Scriptural Prayer:

Glorious Father, we will sing of Your unfailing love forever! Young and old will hear of Your faithfulness. Your unfailing love will last forever. Your faithfulness is as enduring as the heavens. All of heaven will praise Your great wonders, myriads of angels will praise You for Your faithfulness. Who in all of heaven can compare with You, Lord? What mightiest angel is anything like You? The highest angelic powers stand in awe of You. You are far more awesome than all who surround Your throne! Thank You, Father, for being our protector and our King. Thank You, Lord, for the blood of Jesus which covers us and protects us from harm, including disease. Thank You for blessing our staff with the best medical care in the world. Thank You for being the Lord who heals!

Lord Jesus, You are our Light and Salvation, so we will not be afraid regarding our healthcare insurance. You are our fortress and protection from danger, so we will not tremble. We declare that we are not governed by the spirit of fear and timidity, but by Your Spirit of power, love, and self-discipline. As a staff, we declare that we will not give in to panic or fear concern our healthcare. We confess that we will not dread the negative reports that stalk in darkness, nor any disaster that may strike at mid-day. In Jesus' Name, none of these evils of lack or disease will touch us as we make the Most High our refuge and shelter. No evil will conquer and no plague will come near us. We confess that each of us are hidden under God's wing and we are protected from disease and infection. Pray Psalm 91 over yourself and co-workers (also use the additional scriptures):

Holy Spirit, remind us as a staff to eat healthy foods, exercise regularly, and get the proper amount of rest in order to sustain a strong immune system and good health. Speak to us about getting the proper rest. Surround our Pastors, Catrina Wheatley, and Al Scarbrough with favor as they negotiate our healthcare insurance plan. Lord, show Yourself strong on our behalf through low rates at reasonable cost (*continue making your personal requests*).

Faithful Father, we ask that You forgive us for taking our health for granted. Forgive us for panicking about our insurance and for not trusting that You have the power to protect us. Forgive us as a staff for not taken preventive healthcare measures through healthy diets and exercise. Lord, forgive me for (*list the sins, say them out loud to the Lord*). Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. (*Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say out loud, "I forgive name of person(s)."*)

Heavenly Father, help our staff to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

Blessed Father, Your brilliant splendor fills the heavens and the earth is filled with Your praise! Your coming is as brilliant as the sunrise. Heaven is Your throne and earth is Your footstool. Your hands have made both heaven and earth; they and everything in them is Yours! In Jesus' Name, Amen.
