

**Prayer Topic #5:**

**Scripture Reading:**  
I Chronicles 16:8-16, II Chronicles 6

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Almighty God, You sit above the circle of the earth. The people below seem like grasshoppers to You. You spread out the heavens like a curtain and make Your tent from them.
