

Prayer Topic #1:

A Declaration of God's Will for Our Lives

Scripture Reading:

II Samuel 22:31-33, Jeremiah 29:11-12

Scriptural Prayer:

Worthy Father, we thank You for hearing our prayers and giving us Your Word to pray. Thank You for providing the best for our lives. Thank You for having a purpose and plan for each of our lives. Your Name is holy. Lord, we wait quietly before You, for we know our victory comes only from You. You alone are our rock and our salvation, You are our fortress where we will never be shaken.

Gracious Father, as the children and youth in the Body of Christ, we declare that we will prosper and be in health, just as our souls prosper. We will continue to grow in wisdom, stature and favor with You and people. We will honor our mothers and fathers so it will be well with us and our days on this earth will be long. We declare that we will seek Your Kingdom above all else, and live righteously, and we know that You will give us everything that we need. We confess that Your Godly favor surrounds us as with a shield. We will grow to be Godly men and women who will do great things for the Kingdom of God. We will operate as ambassadors of the King and walk in boldness, obedience and Godly authority.

Write down three promises of God and confess those over your life daily:

Holy Spirit, help us to not lean to our own understanding, but to always ask God and trust that He will direct us on the way we should go. Help us to find Godly friends who will encourage us to continue to live holy. Please fill us with God confidence and help us to be all that the Father has created us to be. Remind us to not cut corners or try to take the easy way, but to follow the path for our lives that God has designed for us.

Forgiving Father, please forgive us for all acts of sinfulness including: jealousy, lying, cheating and stealing. Forgive us for selfishness, disobedience and rebellion. Father, forgive us for saying unkind words to our friends. Wash us and cleanse us from our sins. Holy Spirit, create in us clean hearts, and renew a faithful spirit within us. Father, please forgive me for (***list any sin that comes to mind***). Lord, remind us of those we need to forgive; and help us to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. (***Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)."***)

Mighty Father, help us to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

One true Living God, You are the Alpha and Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. You rule from everlasting to everlasting. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
