

Prayer Topic #19:
A Declaration of Obedience to God (Our Father)

Scripture Reading:
Psalm 81:1-4, Deuteronomy 10:12-13

Scriptural Prayer:

Our Father, we thank You for Your love and compassion. Thank You for keeping Your covenant with us. Thank You for making us Your people. Lord, what a joy it is to be one of Your children. You are good and Your faithful love endures forever. You are full of power and might, we bless Your Holy Name. We proclaim Your unfailing love in the morning and Your faithfulness in the evening. Lord, You are compassionate and merciful, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love.

Righteous Father, we will obey Your commands, walk in Your ways, and honor You. Your instructions are perfect, encouraging our souls. Your commands are clear, giving insight for living. Honoring You is pure, lasting forever. Your laws are true and each one is fair. Father, Your Word is more desirable than gold, yes, even the finest gold. Your Word is sweeter than honey dripping from the honeycomb. Your Word warns us and we expect great reward as we obey it. We declare that as we are willing and obedient to You, we will eat the good of the land. We will seek Your Kingdom above all else, and live righteously, and we know that You will give us everything we need.

Holy Spirit, show me where I have been disobedient to the Father and help me to do what is right:

Holy Spirit, show us individually and collectively where we are continually sinning against, the Father. Help us to turn from disobedience and allow You, Holy Spirit, to lead and guide us. Remind us to continue to encourage each other and build each other up on a daily basis.

Compassionate Father, forgive us for the sins we have committed against You including pride, rebellion, disobedience, and selfishness. Lord, forgive me for ***(list any sins that you have committed)***. Holy Spirit, remind each of us of those we need to forgive and help us to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Holy Spirit, help us all to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

Triumphant Lord, You are the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. You are the God who is, and who was, and who is still to come – the Almighty One. All honor and glory belongs to You, God, forever and ever! In Jesus' Name, Amen.
