A Prayer Concerning Building Projects (Missions)

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 29, Philippians 2:1-11

Reflections of the Heart:

Scriptural Prayer:

Thank You for the guidance of the Holy Spirit who will lead them as they implement the plans for the various building projects. We lift Your Name high, Lord! You are great and most worthy of praise. When these building projects are completed, Your awe-inspiring deeds will be on every tongue. We will proclaim Your greatness. Everyone will share the story of Your wonderful goodness. We will sing with joy about Your righteousness. All of Your works will thank You, Lord, and Your faithful followers will praise You. We will speak of the glory of Your Kingdom and give examples of Your power.

Awesome Father, our Church Family declares victory over every building project that You have assigned our mission teams to oversee. We decree that You are with them and You are for them. We proclaim that they are strong and courageous, and they will possess all the land that You have promised to them. Ask the Holy Spirit how you can offer your support to the future global mission projects:

Forgive those who are being disobedient and withholding necessary funds and support for these building projects. Forgive our missionaries for any sins they may have committed. Lord, forgive me for *(list any sins that You have committed)*. Holy Spirit, remind our missionaries of all those they need to forgive and help them to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. *(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show You names or faces of people that You may need to forgive. As He shows You, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in Your soul caused by unforgiveness.)*

Mighty Father, help our mission teams to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

O Holy One of Israel, You reign forever and ever. You made the heavens and earth by Your strong hand and powerful arm. Nothing is too hard for You! You have all wisdom and do great and mighty miracles. You performed miraculous signs and wonders in the land of Egypt - things still remembered to this day!
