Prayer Topic #17:

Scripture Reading:

I Chronicles 16:8-12. Matthew 6:19-34

Reflections of the Heart:

Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)*

Holy Father, help our government and economic leaders not to yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Magnificent Lord, there is none like You. You are great and Your Name is full of power. Who would not fear You, O King of the nations? That title belongs to You alone! Among all the wise people of the earth and in all the kingdoms of the world, there is no one like You. You are the King of glory. You are the Lord of Heaven's Armies.
