Reflections of the Heart:

We bow before Your holy temple as we worship. We praise Your Name for Your unfailing love and faithfulness; Your promises are backed by all the honor of Your Name. Lord, we thank You for hearing from heaven and blessing us. Thank You for Your loving-kindness and tender mercies toward us. Thank You for desiring the best for our lives. Thank You for being our Redeemer, Healer and Deliverer.

Father, we declare that the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus makes us free from the law of sin and death. Therefore, we confess that our Church Family members, relatives, friends, and co-workers who are held captive by the bondage of sin will be set free through Jesus Christ. We declare that they will throw off their old sinful nature and way of living, which is corrupted by lust and deception. We confess that they will be renewed in the spirit of their minds, by putting on the new nature, created to be like God, righteous and holy. Lord, we confess that they will put away lying, and each of them will speak truth with his neighbor. As they do this, we declare that they will give no place to the devil.
