<u>Prayer Topic #7:</u> A Prayer for Educators

<u>Scripture Reading</u>: Psalm 96:1-6, Proverbs 4:7-13

Scriptural Prayer:

Heavenly Father, we thank You for the educators, students and administrators in the Houston Metropolitan Area. Thank You for blessing and protecting them on and off school campus. Thank You for blessing them with wisdom and patience. We bless Your holy Name today. By Your awesome power, You made the earth and by Your wisdom, You preserve it. You are the Lord who stretched out the heavens by Your understanding. We give You praise and glory.

We command the Kingdom of God to come, and our Heavenly Father's will to be done in the lives of all educators. We declare that they are happy because they have found wisdom and continue to gain understanding. They know that wisdom is more valuable than profit from silver and gain from fine gold. Since wisdom is the principle thing, we declare that our educators will seek wisdom. We declare that the wisdom of God will enter and rule their hearts. We confess that they will bind love, truth, and faithfulness around their necks and write them on the tablets of their hearts. As the people of God, we declare that our educators will give wise counsel and instruction, which are the fountains of life.

Ask the Holy Spirit how you can pray for your teacher(s):

Holy Spirit, bless and keep our teachers safe in their classrooms. Lead and guide them as they teach us. Help them to be patient with us and give them creative ways to teach. We ask You to touch the hearts of our local, state and federal law makers to increase funding and resources for our schools.

Loving Father, forgive the sins of our educators. Forgive those who are not fair. Forgive those students who give their teachers a hard time and refuse to be obedient. Lord, forgive me for <u>(list any sins that you have committed.</u>) Holy Spirit, remind our educators to forgive others; and help them to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. (Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "Iforgive name of person(s).")

Almighty Father, help our educators to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Glorious Lord, You are great in Zion and high above all the people. Great and marvelous are Your works, O Lord God, the Almighty. Just and true are Your ways, O King of the nations.

Who will not fear You, Lord, and glorify Your Name? You alone are holy. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
