Scripture Reading:

Psalm 103:1-8. Isaiah 61

Reflections of the Heart:

It is the Lord's good pleasure to bless us. So, "may the Lord, the God of our ancestors, multiply us a thousand times more and bless us as He has promised!" *Deuteronomy 1:11 (NLT)*

Scriptural Prayer:
