

Prayer Topic #10:

A Prayer for Our Soldiers Who are Fighting for Our Country

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 147:7-9, Psalm 27:1-3

Scriptural Prayer

Faithful Father, we thank You for our soldiers who are fighting courageously for our country. Thank You for knowing each of them by name and purpose. We thank You for blessing our military throughout history. We thank You for making our nation a mighty power in the world. We praise and honor Your Name. Your majestic Name fills the earth! Your glory is higher than the heavens. Father, You have made a variety of things! In wisdom, You have made them all. The earth is full of Your creatures.

Wonderful Father, we trust in You and we are expecting You to protect our soldiers. We confess that our military forces will be successful. As our soldiers trust in You and keep their thoughts fixed on You, You will give them peace of mind. We confess that our soldiers will make You their refuge, so no evil will conquer them, neither will any harm come near their homes. We declare that You, Father, will hide our soldiers when trouble comes near them. You will place them out of reach on a high rock. Then they will hold their heads high above all of their enemies who surround them. Then they will offer sacrifices of joy and praise to You.

Merciful Father, we ask You to continue to provide food, clothing, and shelter for the families of our soldiers. Holy Spirit, comfort them and help them to trust You to keep their loved ones who are fighting for our country safe and sound. Help our soldiers to trust in You for guidance and protection. Help those soldiers who are Christians to display Your character wherever they go. Please speak to the children of each soldier and tell them that You will watch over their mom or dad. Help them to trust You to bring their parent(s) home safely.

Do you know anyone whose mom or dad is serving in the military? Ask God how you can pray for them:

Loving Father, please forgive our soldiers for all of their sins, including lying, cheating, stealing, or rebelling against authority. Forgive our nation for not praying often for our soldiers. Father, as for me, please forgive me for ***(list any sin that comes to mind)***. Lord, remind our soldiers of those they need to forgive; and help them to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s).")***

Holy Spirit, help our soldiers to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Sovereign Lord, You reign. There is no one like You. You are great, and Your Name is full of power. Who would not fear You, O King of nations? That title belongs to You alone! In Jesus' Name, Amen.
