A Prayer for the Economy for the Houston Metropolitan Area and United States of America

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 92:1-6, Haggai 1:3-11

Reflections of the Heart:

George Santayana said "Those who cannot learn from history are doomed to repeat it." As we look at the current state of the U.S. economy, let us learn from our past mistakes and declare the word of God over this situation, expecting His divine intervention.

Scriptural Prayer:
