

**Prayer Topic #6:**

**A Prayer for the Outpouring of the Holy Spirit at the 17th Annual Prayer Explosion Conference**

**Scripture Reading:**

Psalm 113, Acts 2:1-21

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Forgive those of us who have not worshipped You, in Spirit and in Truth. Forgive those who speak of the Holy Spirit, but do not allow Him to operate within them. Forgive those who have a form of godliness, but deny Your power. Lord, forgive me for ***(list any sins that you have committed)***. Holy Spirit, remind us of those we need to forgive and help us to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Redeeming Father, help us to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

Lord of Heaven's Armies, Your home reaches up to the heavens, while its foundation is on the earth. You draw up water from the oceans and pour it down as rain on the land. The Lord is Your Name! In the mighty Name of Jesus, Amen.
