

Prayer Topic #13:

A Prayer of Thanksgiving for Mothers

Scripture Reading:

Psalms 36:5-9, Proverbs 31:25-31

Scriptural Prayer:

As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s).")***

Almighty Father, help our mothers to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Glorious King, no one can be compared to You. You sit on Your throne on high. You stoop down to look on heaven and earth. You are an awesome God! In Jesus' Name, Amen.
