As teen girls, help us all to be kind, fair, and friendly. Holy Spirit, some teen girls are ensnared by the sexual perversions of this world. Please remove the scales from all our eyes and circumcise our hearts so that we can see ourselves reflected in God's Word. Remind us that we are a chosen people, royal priests, a holy nation, Your very own possession. Deliver us all from the shame and anger that perversion and sin creates in our hearts and minds. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you,***

***say aloud, “I forgive name of person(s).” Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Holy Spirit, help us as teen girls to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.
