# Government Professionals' Prayer of Love for God and Their Neighbor

#### Scripture Reading:

Psalm 138:2, I John 4:7-21

#### Reflections of the Heart:

"Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony." ~ Colossians 3:14

## <u>ONE Prayer:</u>

Almighty Father, thank You for loving government professionals. Thank You for giving them the Holy Spirit to fill their hearts with Your love, so that they may share love with their neighbors. Thank You for helping them to be more loving and compassionate towards people. Lord, we come before You clapping our hands and shouting joyful praise to You. You are the great King of all the earth. You subdue the nations before us and put our enemies under our feet. Our hearts are confident in You, Father. Because of this confidence, we will sing Your praises. We will wake the dawn with our song, Lord, among all the people. We will sing Your praises among the nations for Your unfailing love is as high as the heavens. Your faithfulness reaches to the clouds.

Glorious Father, we decree that government professionals will commit to loving You with all their hearts, and with all their souls, and with all their minds. This is the greatest and most important commandment of all. In the same spirit, they will commit to loving their neighbors as themselves. We confess that the Holy Spirit will fill and control them as they commit to doing Your will. They will be patient and kind instead of acting jealous, boastful, proud or rude. They will not demand their own way, but will be considerate of others and their opinions. They will not be irritable or keep a record of being wronged. But they will be joyful and quick to forgive. They will commit to living a righteous life. They will be patient and will not return evil with evil. They will let their light shine so that people will see their good works and glorify You, Father.

### As a government professional, how will you show your love for God and for your neighbor by your actions?

Holy Spirit, reveal to government professionals the habits, mindsets and attitudes that prevent them from being truly obedient to the Father. Help them to not be deceived to think that they are walking in love while using their tongues to curse people who have been made in the Father's image. In this world where they are told to put themselves first, help them to truly put the Father first in their lives, and to esteem their neighbor better than themselves.

Exalted Father, forgive government professionals for all acts of sinfulness. Forgive them for, at times, being irreverent and apathetic towards You. Forgive those who murmur and complain and do not show love and appreciation for all that You do. Forgive those who are impatient with their neighbor. Forgive those who pick and choose to whom they will show love. Lord, forgive me for *(list any sins that you have committed)*. Holy Spirit, remind government professionals of those they need to forgive and help them to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. *(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive <u>name of person(s)</u>." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)* 

Holy Spirit, help government professionals to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Eternal Lord, You are God alone. You created the heavens and the earth; You put everything in its place. You made the world to be lived in, not a place of empty chaos. You are the Lord and there is no other. You only speak what is true and declare only what is right. In Jesus' Name, Amen
