FASTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH

God gives us pastors according to His heart who will feed us with knowledge and understanding (Jeremiah 3:15). We must obey our pastors for they watch over our souls (Hebrews 13:17).

Parents should teach and guide by their example the importance of following the leadership of our pastors. When Pastor Caldwell proclaims the fast, children and youth are capable of obeying and participating.

Parents, please prayerfully consider including your children and youth in the Church Family Spiritual Fast. It will be a blessed experience for them and it will begin to lay a foundation for their future. Your support and encouragement are recommended to maximize your child's success.

I. What is a Fast?

The Hebrew word for fasting means "to cover the mouth." Fasting has been a part of Christianity through the ages. It is a form of spiritual and scriptural sacrifice. Fasting does not change or impress God. Fasting changes us. Through fasting, Christians are empowered to discipline their daily relationship with the Lord.

II. Why Should Children and Youth Fast?

- To have a closer relationship with God our Father and Jesus Christ;
- To become more sensitive and responsive to the Holy Spirit;
- To present the opportunity for you to spend more time waiting on the Lord; and,
- To build your prayer life.

As children and youth fast, they, too, will receive the benefits and blessings of obedience and fasting.

III. How to Fast

- Eat breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
- Eat healthy vegetables, fruits, meats, breads, milk, and cereal.
- Eat a healthy snack between meals such as fruit, vegetables, etc.
- Drink WATER, 100% JUICE, and MILK as the only beverages.

HOW TO USE YOUR KINGDOM BUILDERS' POWER GUIDE FOR CHILDREN

The Children's Prayer Guide is designed to assist children with daily prayer and Bible reading. This is a great opportunity for parents and children to bond together. Suggested guidelines for using the Children's Power Guide are:

- 1. Use your Power Guide daily before school, after school or before bedtime. Set aside a few minutes each day to pray.**
- 2. Read the scriptures under "Scripture Reading" and pray the "Scriptural Prayer" for each day. Use the Prayer Topic Calendar located on page 6 to find the prayer topic for each day.**
- 3. Read the scriptures and pray the daily prayer out loud. When you speak God's Word out loud, you produce His power to get things done for Him.**
- 4. Use your faith and believe that God hears you praying.**
- 5. After you pray the daily prayer topic, relax, listen and journal two or more sentences of your thoughts and reflections on the Prayer Expectation page. Be sure to ask God, the Holy Spirit, to help you.**
- 6. Before finishing your prayer time, say your power confession for the day, by using the Daily Power Confessions located at the back of your Power Guide. Say them out loud with lots of excitement.**
- 7. Enjoy your daily prayer time spent with the Lord!**

Prayer Topic #1:

A Prayer of Thanksgiving for Jesus Christ, Our Resurrected Savior

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 138:1-3, Luke 4:14-19

Scriptural Prayer:

Our Holy Father, we thank You for giving us Your Son, Jesus Christ, our Passover Lamb. Thank You, Jesus, for being our Savior. Thank You, Holy Spirit, for leading our lives. You are an awesome God! Lord, we will mediate on Your majestic, glorious splendor and Your wonderful miracles. Your awesome deeds will be on every tongue; we will proclaim Your greatness. Everyone will share the story of Your wonderful goodness and will sing with joy about Your righteousness.

Mighty Father, we declare that Jesus is the Lamb of God who came to take away the sin of the world. Just as You delivered the children of Israel from Egypt by the blood of a lamb, we have been delivered from sin through the blood of Jesus Christ. We thank You, Jesus, for offering Yourself on the cross and freeing us from the bondage of sin forever. Hallel YAH! Thank You for bringing us back into relationship with God, the Father.

How would you tell Jesus ‘thank You’ for the love He has shown you and your family?

Holy Spirit, help us to really think about what Jesus did for us and spend time thanking and praising Him. Help us to not take His work on the cross for granted. Help us to share the good news of the Gospel with our friends and family.

Holy Spirit, forgive us for not sharing the story of Jesus, our Passover Lamb, with others. Forgive us for not being thankful for the gift You gave us through Your Son, Jesus Christ, so that we might be saved from our sins. Please forgive me for ***(list any sin that comes to mind)***. Lord, remind us of those we need to forgive; and we will be quick to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, “I forgive name of person(s).”)***

Holy Spirit, as a Church Family, help us not to yield to temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

Great and Mighty Lord, You are the only true God. You are the living God and the everlasting King! In Jesus’ Name, Amen.

You are the One who forgives all our sins, heals our diseases, redeems our lives from death, and crowns us with love and tender mercies. We honor You as our Lord and Savior.

Holy Father, we declare that every person who confesses with their mouth that Jesus is Lord and believes in their heart that You raised Him from the dead, will be saved. We declare that we are not ashamed of the Good News about Christ. We know it is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes. We confess that we will be obedient as children of God so that the world will see the difference in us. We are the salt of the earth and the light of the world. We will live in such a way that our good deeds will shine and everyone will praise our Heavenly Father.

Can you think of a friend(s) or schoolmate(s) who doesn't know Jesus Christ? Write their names down and pray for them to be saved.

Holy Spirit, help us to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with everyone, especially with people who don't know Him. Father, as Your Word goes forth, touch the hearts of the unsaved to receive it. Please show us anything about ourselves that is not pleasing to God. Help us, Holy Spirit, to change any bad attitudes or behaviors we may have. Help us to be excited about living for Jesus so that our unsaved friends will want to know Him, too.

Glorious Father, forgive us for not sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with our friends. Forgive the unsaved for not accepting You as their Lord and Savior. Please forgive those of us who know You who do not let the light of Jesus Christ shine through our lives. Father, please forgive me for ***(list any sin that comes to mind)***. Lord, remind all of us of those we need to forgive; and help us to be quick to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, "I forgive name of person(s).")***

Holy Spirit, help us to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

Holy, Holy, Holy are You, the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come. You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive all glory and all honor and all power. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

We seek Your will in all that we do and in every situation, we trust that You will show us which path to take. We will continue to turn away from those things that lead us away from You, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. Holy Spirit, help us all not to yield to temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

Triumphant Lord, all glory belongs to You, who alone are God. All glory, majesty, power and authority are Yours before all time and in the present and beyond all time! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Lord, we Your Godly children, sing for joy to You. We praise You with melodies on the lyre and make music to You on the harp. We will sing a new song of praise to You because Your Word is true and we can trust everything that You do. You love what is just and good and Your unfailing love fills the earth.

Wonderful Father, as a Church Family, we declare that You are our source of hope and that we are filled completely with joy and peace because we trust in You. We overflow with confident hope and joy through the power of the Holy Spirit. We know that the joy of the Lord is our strength, so we will not allow the cares of this life to cause us to turn from You or Your Word. We decree, Father, that this is the day that You have made and we will rejoice and be glad in it.

What is keeping you from walking in God's joy? Jot those things down, and then talk to God about them:

As He reveals them, say, "I forgive name of person(s)."***

Holy Spirit, help us all not to yield to temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

Almighty Lord, You are the blessed and only Almighty God. The King of kings, and the Lord of lords. You alone can never die. You live in light so brilliant that no human can approach You. No human eye has ever seen You, nor ever will. To You belongs all honor and power forever and ever. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

The silver and gold is Yours! Therefore, as Your people, we will *achieve* with the same anointing that came upon Israel, for that anointing remains here with us, now!

Holy Spirit, as we receive wealth, help us to remember that it is the Lord who gives us the power to get wealth to fulfill His covenant. Remind us not to hoard Your financial blessings. Help us to not be afraid or intimidated by the world, nor be impressed by the appearance of its power and influence.

Write down one thing that you will spend less time doing during this special time so that you can spend more time with God:

Jesus Is Risen!

(Luke Chapters 22-24)



Jesus' last week on earth was very busy. His week began with Palm Sunday. On Palm Sunday, Jesus rode on a donkey through the city of Jerusalem as people waved branches of palm trees and shouted "Hosanna, blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord". On Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, Jesus continued being about His Heavenly Father's business by healing and teaching. On Thursday, Jesus experienced the Passover meal with the disciples. When the unleavened bread and the fruit of the vine were served, Jesus said it was His body and blood. This was the last Passover Supper Jesus had with the disciples. Today, you call this meal the Last Supper or Communion.

On Friday, after the Passover supper, Jesus went to pray in a garden filled with olive trees, called the garden of Gethsemane. In the garden of Gethsemane, one of the disciples proved not to be a good friend. His name was Judas Iscariot. Some bad men had paid him with 30 pieces of silver to tell them where Jesus was praying. Soldiers bullied Jesus, beat Him and laughed at Him. Later, it was decided that Jesus would be punished in a very ugly way. He was nailed to a rough, wooden cross. He was crucified. All day Friday, Jesus hung on a cross between two criminals. Afterward, Jesus was placed in a tomb which is like a small cave. On Sunday, God instructed the angels to remove the stone from the tomb, and guess what? Jesus wasn't in the tomb anymore. He had risen! Now, everyone who believes in Jesus can be saved (Romans 10:9-10)!
