

HOW TO USE YOUR CHILDREN'S POWER GUIDE "...Let the little children come to Me..." Luke 18:16

The Children's Prayer Guide is designed to assist children with daily prayer and Bible reading. This is a great opportunity for parents and children to bond together. The guidelines for using the Children's Power Guide are:

- 1. Use your Power Guide daily before school, after school or before bedtime. Set aside a few minutes each day to pray.
- 2. Read the Scriptures under "Scripture Reading" and pray the "Scriptural Prayer" for each day. Use the Prayer Topic Calendar located on page 5 to find the prayer topic for each day.
- 3. Read the Scriptures and pray the daily prayer out loud. God wants to hear your voice.
- 4. Use your faith and believe that God hears you pray ing.
- 5. After you pray the daily prayer topic, relax, listen and journal two or more sentences of your thoughts and reflections on the Prayer Expectation page 32. Be sure to ask God, the Holy Spirit, to help you.
- 6. Before finishing your prayer time, say your power confession for the day by using the Daily Power Confessions located at the back of your Power Guide. Say them out loud with lots of excitement.
- 7. Enjoy your daily prayer time spent with the Lord!

Prayer Topic #1:

A Prayer Summer Vacation Prayer for Our Windsor Village Church Families

<u>Scripture Reading:</u> Psalm 47, Ecclesiastes 3:9-13

Scriptural Prayer:

If you could spend the day with your family doing anything you want, what would you do? Show your parents your answer and talk to them to see if you can do it:

For those of us who are staying home this summer, show us fun things we can do at home or around town. Remind us to spend quality time with You daily during our summer vacation. Righteous Father, forgive us of all our sins. Forgive us for sometimes forgetting the importance of rest. Forgive our families for not always being nice to one another. Father, please forgive me for (*list any sin that comes to mind*). Lord, remind all of us of those we need to forgive; and help us to be quick to forgive. (*Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, "I forgive name of person(s)."*)

Holy Spirit, help us not to yield to temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

Royal King, what a variety of things You have made! In Your wisdom, You have made them all. The earth is full of Your creatures. May Your glory continue forever! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

<u>Prayer Topic #2:</u> A Prayer for Salvation

<u>Scripture Reading</u>: Psalm 104:31-34, John 3:16-18

Scriptural Prayer:

Can you think of a friend(s) or schoolmate(s) who doesn't know Jesus Christ? Write their names down and pray for them to be saved.

Holy Spirit, help us to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with everyone, especially with people who don't know Him. Father, as Your Word goes forth, touch the hearts of the unsaved to receive it. Please show us anything about ourselves that is not pleasing to God. Help us, Holy Spirit, to change any bad attitudes or behaviors we may have. Help us to be excited about living for Jesus so that our unsaved friends will want to know Him, too.

Glorious Father, forgive us for not sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with our friends. Forgive the unsaved for not accepting You as their Lord and Savior. Please forgive those of us who know You who do not let the light of Jesus Christ shine through our lives. Father, please forgive me for (*list any sin that comes to mind*). Lord, remind all of us of those we need to forgive; and help us to be quick to forgive. (*Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, "I forgive <u>name of person(s)</u>.")*

Holy Spirit, help us not to yield to temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

Holy, Holy, Holy are You, the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come. You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive all glory and all honor and all power. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scriptural Prayer:

Lord, as Your children, we shout joyfully to You; for You are the Rock of our salvation. Holy Spirit, show me how to study the Bible so I can grow in Godly wisdom:

Scriptural Prayer:

Loving Father, we praise Your Name because You are good. We celebrate Your lovely Name with music. We know Your greatness and that You, our Lord, are greater than any other god. Your Name, O Lord, endures forever; Your fame is known to every generation. You are righteous in everything that You do; You are filled with kindness.

Eternal Father, we confess that the older men in our Church Family exercise self-control, are worthy of respect and live wisely. They have strong faith and are filled with love and patience. We declare that our senior women are honorable and righteous. They teach others what is good and train the younger women in our Church Family to love their husbands and their children, to live wisely and be pure, to work in their homes, to do good, and to honor their husbands. We decree that our senior men are models of God's strength and faithfulness and they teach our young men to respect authority, provide for their wives and children, live wisely, lead with love and fairness, and love their wives like Christ loves the church.

Forgive those who have allowed life to cause them to grow bitter and angry. Forgive those who do not check on or spend time with their older relatives. Lord, forgive me for <u>(list any sins that you have committed</u>). Holy Spirit, remind our seniors of those they need to forgive and help them to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. (Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, "I forgive <u>name of person(s)</u>.")

Holy Spirit, remind our senior adults not to yield to temptation but deliver them from the evil one.

Lord, there is no one like You! You are great, and Your Name is full of power. Who would not fear You, O King of the nations? That title belongs to You alone! All glory majesty, power and authority are Yours before all time, and in the present, and beyond all time. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
