Fasting Instructions for Children and Youth

God gives us pastors according to His heart who will feed us with knowledge and understanding (Jeremiah 3:15). We must obey our pastors for they watch over our souls (Hebrews 13:17).

Parents should teach and guide by their example the importance of following the leadership of our pastors. When Pastor Caldwell proclaims the fast, children and youth are capable of obeying and participating.

Parents, please prayerfully consider including your children and youth in the Church Family Spiritual Fast. It will be a blessed experience for them and it will begin to lay a foundation for their future. Your support and encouragement are recommended to maximize your child's success.

I. What is a Fast?

The Hebrew word for fasting means "to cover the mouth." Fasting has been a part of Christianity through the ages. It is a form of spiritual and scriptural sacrifice. Fasting does not change or impress God. Fasting changes us. Through fasting, Christians are empowered to discipline their daily relationship with the Lord.

II. Why Should Children and Youth Fast?

To have a closer relationship with God our Father and Jesus Christ;
To become more sensitive and responsive to the Holy Spirit;
To present the opportunity for you to spend more time waiting on the Lord; and
To build your prayer life.

As children and youth fast, they, too, will receive the benefits and blessings of obedience and fasting.

III. How to Fast

Eat breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
Eat healthy vegetables, fruits, meats, breads, milk, and cereal.
Eat a healthy snack between meals such as fruit, vegetables, etc.
Drink WATER, 100% JUICE, and MILK as the only beverages.

HOW TO USE YOUR CHILDREN'S POWER GUIDE

"...Let the little children come to Me..." Luke 18:16

The Children's Prayer Guide is designed to assist children with daily prayer and Bible reading. This is a great opportunity for parents and children to bond together. The guidelines for using the Children's Power Guide are:

1. Use your Power Guide daily before school, after school or before bedtime. Set aside a few minutes each day to pray.
2. Read the Scriptures under "Scripture Reading" and pray the "Scriptural Prayer" for each day. *Use the Prayer Topic Calendar located on page 8 to find the prayer topic for each day.*
3. Read the Scriptures and pray the daily prayer out loud. God wants to hear your voice.
4. Use your faith and believe that God hears you praying.
5. After you pray the daily prayer topic, relax, listen and journal two or more sentences of your thoughts and reflections on the Prayer Expectation page. Be sure to ask God, the Holy Spirit, to help you.
6. Before finishing your prayer time, say your power confession for the day by using the Daily Power Confessions located at the back of your Power Guide. Say them out loud with lots of excitement.
7. Enjoy your daily prayer time spent with the Lord!

Prayer Topics

Prayer Topic #1:

A Prayer of Preparation for the Fall Feasts

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 117, Ecclesiastes 3

Reflections of the Heart:

God has already prepared His plans for our lives. Now, it is up to us to believe that He has plans for us and expect His plans to be implemented in our lives. Today, declare God's Word over your life and expect His supernatural plans to become earthly realities. Our time under God is now!

Scriptural Prayer:

Our Father, we thank You for demonstrating Your loving-kindness and tender mercies towards us. Thank You for sending Your Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem us from the power of the evil one. Thank You for Your appointed times and seasons. We are thankful for Your presence in our lives. Lord, there is none like You. You are great and Your Name is full of power. Who would not fear You, O King of the nations? That title belongs to You alone. Among all the wise people of the earth and in all the kingdoms of the world, there is no one like You.

Omniscient Father, we know that there is a season for everything. There is a time for every purpose under heaven. As a Church Family, we make our declaration to celebrate the Fall Feasts and spend time with You. We declare that the Feast of Trumpets, the Day of Atonement and the Feast of Tabernacles are Your appointed times and we will observe them. By faith, we expect to experience Your love, power, and presence in the New Year. On the day of the Feast of Trumpets, when the trumpets sound, we, as a Church Family, will assemble together and respond to the call to honor Your faithfulness. During the High Holy Days and on the Day of Atonement, we will afflict our souls with prayer and fasting. We will re-evaluate our lives, repent for our sins, and draw closer to You. During the Feast of Tabernacles, we will remember that Christ has become our High Priest over all the good things that have come. He has entered that greater, more perfect Tabernacle in heaven, which was not made by human hands. Jesus Christ, our big brother, has secured our redemption forever. Hallel YAH!

Holy Spirit, help us to reflect, repent, reconcile, remember, and

rejoice. Cause the mind of Christ to be in us. Show us how to celebrate our Father God during the Fall Feasts. What can we do and say to show our love and make You happy? You continue to bless us over and over. How can we bless You? Show us what it is that pleases You. Please help us to slow down during this month of September to spend quality time with You. Reveal to us what needs to be changed or improved in our lives. Help us to mend broken relationships. Continue to touch our hearts about the Father's will for our lives. Cause Your peace to settle into our hearts.

Compassionate Father, forgive us for all acts of sinfulness including: idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, envy, murders, drunkenness, and revelries. Lord, forgive me for **(list any sins that you have committed)**. Holy Spirit, remind us all of those we need to forgive and help us to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Holy Spirit, help us all to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

Lord, You are the only true God. You are the living God and the everlasting King! The whole earth trembles at Your anger and the nations cannot stand up to Your wrath. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scriptural Prayer:

We honor You and we bless You. With our whole hearts and all that we are, we will praise Your holy Name. We give thanks to You and declare Your greatness. We will sing praises to You and tell everyone about Your wonderful deeds.

Righteous Father, we declare that our teachers trust in You with all of their hearts and not depend on their own understanding. As they seek Your will in all that they do, we know that You will show them which path to take for the remainder of the school year. We declare that our teachers are not anxious about anything, but they pray about everything and tell You what they need and thank You for all that You have done. As they do this, they experience Your peace which is greater than anything they can understand. We declare that they are filled with Your glorious power to instruct and teach us.

List three of your teachers. Now ask the Holy Spirit to help you to pray for them:

If any of our teachers are unsaved, help them to see Your light shining through us so that they will confess with their mouths the Lord Jesus and believe in their hearts that You raised Jesus from the dead so they will be saved. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s).")***

Holy Spirit, help our teachers to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty. Just and true are Your ways, King of the nations. Who will not fear You and glorify Your Name? In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Scriptural Prayer:

Heavenly Father, our souls honor You. Thank You for our family relationships. Lord, we thank You for fulfilling Your plans and purposes in our lives and for surrounding us with favor like a shield. Thank You for blessing us continually with Your loving-kindness and tender mercies. Your mercy endures forever. You are great and Your power is absolute. Your understanding is beyond comprehension. We love You and extol Your Holy Name.

Glorious Father, we declare that our families will live in peaceful habitations, in safe dwellings, and in quiet resting places. We declare that stability, salvation, love, wisdom and knowledge abide in each home. Lord, we rebuke the spirits of argument, slander, strife, perversion, violence, offense, lies, rebellion, disobedience and cruelty in our families. We break all soul ties, strongholds and generational curses in our family bloodlines. No weapon formed against our families will prosper. We call for a spiritual renewal and restoration in our families. Father, we will hold fast to the confession of our faith without wavering. We confess that the love of God will reign supreme in our homes and the peace of God is an umpire in our family relationships. We decree that because our families seek Your Kingdom above all else, and live righteously, we will have everything that we stand in need of.

Scriptural Prayer:
Holy Father, we thank You for bringing us through the journey of the past year. We thank You for giving us a hope and a future. Thank You for redeeming our souls through the Blood of Jesus. Thank You for new beginnings and Your redemptive power at work in us through the Holy Spirit. Together, as a Church Family, we rejoice in the celebration of the Feast of Trumpets. Be exalted, O God, above the highest heavens! May Your glory shine over all the earth. Our hearts are confident in You, Father. No wonder we can sing Your praises! We will thank You, Lord, among all the people. We will sing Your praises among the nations, for Your unfailing love is as high as the heavens. Your faithfulness reaches to the clouds.

Majestic Father, we are grateful to enter into this season humbly and soberly. We understand that only those whose hands and hearts are pure, who do not worship idols, and who never tell lies, can stand in Your holy presence. We thank You for making us holy, blameless, and above reproach through Jesus Christ. It is through His blood, our hearts are made pure and our hands are made clean. The Three Hebrew Boys and The Fiery Furnace

Daniel Chapters 1 and 3



Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were four Hebrew boys who lived in Babylon. These four boys loved God. They worshipped and obeyed the only true and living God. Daniel 1:17 tells us that because they obeyed God, He gave them knowledge, skill and wisdom. God blessed them to be very smart and to make very wise decisions.

The king of Babylon was Nebuchadnezzar. King Nebuchadnezzar made a golden statue as an idol god and he decreed to the people of Babylon, “When the music plays, you must bow down and worship this gold statue.” One day the music played and Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego refused to bow down and worship the gold statue. The king became angry. He was so angry that he ordered his men to throw the three Hebrew boys into a hot furnace. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego trusted God to take care of them in the fiery furnace. Even though the fire in the furnace was very hot, God did not allow the fire to hurt them. When King Nebuchadnezzar saw how God took care of them, he made a decree and said that there is no other God like their God. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego were faithful to obey God and God was faithful to His promise to take care of them.

As you prepare for the new school year, this story will help you to remember, that as you pray and study, trust God to give you wisdom, knowledge, and understanding in all of your classes. Also, when you maintain a life of integrity (honesty) and good character (responsible), expect God’s best for your life.

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
