- 5. After you pray the daily prayer topic, relax, listen and journal two or more sentences of your thoughts and reflections on the Prayer Expectation page. Be sure to ask God, the Holy Spirit, to help you.
- Before finishing your prayer time, say your power confession for the day by using the Daily Power Confessions located at the back of your Power Guide. Say them out loud with lots of excitement.
- 7. Enjoy your daily prayer time spent with the Lord!

Scripture Reading:

Psalm 86:11-13, James 5:13-16

Scriptural Prayer:

Compassionate Father, forgive those persons who have doubted Your Word and Your miraculous works. Lord, please forgive them and restore to them the ⁶joy of Your salvation. Father,

please forgive me for (<u>list any sin that comes to mind</u>). Lord, remind those who need healing of those they need to forgive; and help them to be quick to forgive. (Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say aloud, "I forgive <u>name of person(s)</u>.")

Holy Spirit, help those who need healing to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Holy Lord, You are the only true God. You are the living God and the everlasting King. You made the earth by Your power and preserve it by Your wisdom. With Your own understanding, You stretched out the heavens. We bless Your holy Name. In the Name of Jesus, Amen.

Thank You for helping military personnel, law enforcement and intelligence agencies as they root out the people who are involved in these terrorist attacks. We give thanks to You, Lord, for You are good and Your mercy endures forever. Lord, when You spoke, the world began and appeared at Your command!

Almighty Father, by the authority given to us in Jesus' Name, we command peace be still! We rebuke the spirit of terror and cancel the schemes and assignments of every evil spirit, including the spirits of deception, rebellion, and confusion that are in alignment with the spirit of terror. We command every person worldwide who is plotting against the good of humanity be exposed and captured. Lord of Heaven's Armies, we are expecting to witness Your mighty power against this evil and see a mighty outpouring of Your love through the Body of Christ.

As you watch the news, jot down those areas of the world that are under attack from terrorists and ask the Holy Spirit for wisdom on how to pray:

nations, including our own. Father, with people some things are impossible, but with You all things are possible. We are trusting in You!

Merciful Father, forgive the terrorists for their murderous acts. Forgive us all for our many sins. Please extend Your mercy to all the nations of the world who have been attacked by terrorists; to refugees fleeing the violence; and those who have lost loved ones. We all need Your help! Father, forgive me for <u>(list any sins that you have committed)</u>. Holy Spirit, remind us all of those we need to forgive and help us to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. (Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s).")

Holy Spirit, help those devastated by terrorism to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Great and marvelous are Your actions, Lord God Almighty. Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints. Who will not fear You and glorify Your Name? You alone are Holy. All nations will come and worship before You, for Your righteous deeds have been revealed. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

With our whole beings, bodies and souls, we will shout joyfully to You, the Living God!

Ever present Father, we trust in Your Word and believe that it will become alive in the hearts and minds of our members who feel sad or lonely. We declare that those who are sad will bring their problems to You and exchange their sadness for Your rest. We confess that the power of Your right hand will save those who are sad and surrounded by trouble. We declare that the time of Your favor has come for those who are sad and that You will give them a crown of beauty and a joyous blessing in exchange for their sorrow and festive praise instead of worry.

Holy Spirit, please comfort those who are sad. Remind them to cast their cares upon God because He cares for them and He will not allow the Godly to slip and fall. Help them to press through their sadness and continue to worship and praise God and expect joy to return quickly. Please send someone to help them and encourage them.
