HOW TO USE YOUR CHILDREN'S POWER GUIDE "...Let the little children come to Me..." Luke 18:16

The Children's Prayer Guide is designed to assist children with daily prayer and Bible reading. This is a great opportunity for parents and children to bond together. The guidelines for using the Children's Power Guide are:

- 1. Use your Power Guide daily before school, after school or before bedtime. Set aside a few minutes each day to pray.
- 2. Read the Scriptures under "Scripture Reading" and pray the "Scriptural Prayer" for each day. Use the Prayer Topic Calendar located on page 5 to find the prayer topic for each day.
- 3. Read the Scriptures and pray the daily prayer out loud. God wants to hear your voice.
- 4. Use your faith and believe that God hears you praying.
- 5. After you pray the daily prayer topic, relax, listen and journal two or more sentences of your thoughts and reflections on the Prayer Expectation page. Be sure to ask God, the Holy Spirit, to help you.
- 6. Before finishing your prayer time, say your power confession for the day by using the Daily Power Confessions located at the back of your Power Guide. Say them out loud with lots of excitement.
- 7. Enjoy your daily prayer time spent with the Lord!

<u>Prayer Topic #1</u>: A Prayer of Adoration for God and His Word

<u>Scripture Reading</u>: Psalm 147:7-11, Isaiah 6:1-4

Scriptural Prayer:

Wonderful God, our Father, thank You for Your love and compassion towards us. Thank You for making us Your people. What a joy it is to be one of Your children. Thank You for loving us and taking care of us. You alone are our inheritance and our cup of blessing. You guard all that is ours. We live in a pleasant land; what a wonderful inheritance! You are good and Your faithful love endures forever.

Holy Father, we honor You. You are the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. You existed before time and created everything that exists. We acknowledge that You are the only living God. There are no other gods. Loving Father, You are full of grace and mercy, slow to anger and filled with love that will never fail. You are good to everyone and You shower compassion on all of Your creation. We praise You, Lord, for hearing and answering our cries. You are our strength and shield. We trust You with all of our hearts. You help us and our hearts are filled with joy. We praise You with songs of thanksgiving! You are the King of glory and the Lord of Heaven's Armies.

Holy Spirit, help us to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

Lord, all honor and glory belongs to God forever and ever! You are the eternal King, the unseen one who never dies; You alone are God. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Prayer Topic #2:

<u>Scriptural Reading</u>: Psalm 93:1-2, John 3:16-17

Scriptural Prayer:

Awesome Father, we thank You for the gift of salvation through Your Son, Jesus Christ. Thank You, for Your everlasting love toward our family members, friends and enemies who are unbelievers. We thank You that we are not too young to be effective witnesses of Your love, grace and mercy. Your majestic Name fills the earth. Your glory is higher than the heavens. We praise You, Lord, with our whole hearts; we will tell of all the awesome things You have done. We are filled with joy because of You.

Eternal Father, it is Your will that everyone be saved and understand Your truth. We confess that Jesus Christ is the Way, the Truth and the Life. He is the only way that a person can be saved. We declare that when our unsaved family members, friends and enemies confess with their mouths that Jesus is Lord and believe in their hearts that You raised Jesus from the dead, they will be saved. We confess that as they surrender to Jesus Christ, they will become new people, their old way of living will be gone and they will begin a new life!

Holy Spirit, please surround our family members, friends, and enemies with godly people who will share God's Word with them. Please draw them to the Father and give them an ear to hear and a heart to receive the gift of salvation. Holy Spirit, help us to speak God's Word with boldness to those who are not saved. Touch their hearts to believe and receive eternal life through Jesus Christ.

Blessed Lord, You are great and most worthy of praise! You are God Almighty. You sit on Your throne between the cherubim. You sit in majesty, exalted above all the nations. We bless You, Lord, in Jesus' Name, Amen.

Holy King, all the nations You made will come and bow before You; they will praise Your Holy Name. You are great and perform wonderful deeds. You alone are God! In the Name of Jesus, Amen.

Holy Spirit, help our business owners to not yield to temptation; but deliver them from the evil one.

Joshua and the Israelites obeyed all of God's specific instructions and they received exactly what God had promised, they conquered the city of Jericho.

When we accept Jesus Christ as our Savior and Lord, we become God's children. As God's children, we also receive God's promises in the Bible as we obey God's specific instructions. 


