- 3. Read the Scriptures and pray the daily prayer out loud. God wants to hear your voice.**
- 4. Use your faith and believe that God hears you praying.**
- 5. After you pray the daily prayer topic, relax, listen and journal two or more sentences of your thoughts and reflections on the Prayer Expectation page. Be sure to ask God, the Holy Spirit, to help you.**
- 6. Before finishing your prayer time, say your power confession for the day by using the Daily Power Confessions located at the back of your Power Guide. Say them out loud with lots of excitement.**
- 7. Enjoy your daily prayer time spent with the Lord!**

## **Fasting Instructions for Children and Youth**

God gives us pastors according to His heart who will feed us with knowledge and understanding (Jeremiah 3:15). We must obey our pastors for they watch over our souls (Hebrews 13:17).

Parents should teach and guide by their example the importance of following the leadership of our pastors. When Pastor Caldwell proclaims the fast, children and youth are capable of obeying and participating.

Parents, please prayerfully consider including your children and youth in the Church Family Spiritual Fast. It will be a blessed experience for them and it will begin to lay a foundation for their future. Your support and encouragement are recommended to maximize your child's success.

### **What is a Fast?**

The Hebrew word for fasting means "to cover the mouth." Fasting has been a part of Christianity through the ages. It is a form of spiritual and scriptural sacrifice. Fasting does not change or impress God. Fasting changes us. Through fasting, Christians are empowered to discipline their daily relationship with the Lord.

### **Why Should Children and Youth Fast?**

- To have a closer relationship with God our Father and Jesus Christ;
- To become more sensitive and responsive to the Holy Spirit;
- To present the opportunity for you to spend more time waiting on the Lord; and
- To build your prayer life.

As children and youth fast, they, too, will receive the benefits and blessings of obedience and fasting.

### **How to Fast**

- Eat breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
- Eat healthy vegetables, fruits, meats, breads, milk, and cereal.
- Eat a healthy snack between meals such as fruit, vegetables, etc.
- Drink WATER, 100% JUICE, and MILK as the only beverages.

***NO SWEETS, PIZZA, FRENCH FRIES, CHIPS, CANDY, CHEWING GUM, SOFT DRINKS, OR ANY OTHER JUNK FOODS!***

**Prayer Topic #1:**

**A Prayer for Justice and Righteousness in the United States**

**Scripture Reading:**

Psalm 135:1-7, Isaiah 51:4-5,7-8

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Thank You for moving on the hearts of Your people to establish peace, justice and righteousness in the earth. Lord, we will praise You with all of our hearts. We confess that justice and righteousness will prevail in our nation, homes, workplaces, churches, schools and communities. We confess that we will walk in righteousness and integrity. We will not discriminate against anyone because of their race, their sex, or their age. We will not pay back evil with more evil, but we will always do things in such a way that everyone can see that we are honorable.

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Thank You that You have given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with Your love, so that we may share love with others. We thank You that, as we have received a Kingdom which is unshakable, we will be thankful and please You by worshipping You with holy fear and awe. Mighty King, You are a devouring fire.

Wonderful Father, as Your dear children, we commit to love You with all our hearts, and with all our souls, and with all our minds. This is the greatest and most important commandment of all. We give thanks to You and proclaim Your greatness. We will sing to You the praises due Your Name and tell everyone about Your wonderful deeds. Father, You are our God; we earnestly search for You.

Righteous Father, Your Word tells us that if we forgive those who have sinned against us, then You, our Heavenly Father, will forgive us. Today, we choose to forgive. We declare that we will make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who has offended us. Lord, we remember that You have forgiven, therefore we must forgive others. As a Church Family, we choose to owe nothing to anyone, except for our obligation to love them. We confess that as we love our neighbors, we fulfill the requirement of God's law.

You are great and most worthy of praise. You are to be feared above all gods. You are the King of glory; the Lord strong and mighty. Omniscient Father, You said that You would give rest to all who are weary and heavy burdened. Your yoke is easy and Your burdens are light. We are supposed to trust in You with all of our hearts and not depend on our own understanding. We trust in Your Word and believe that it will be operative in the hearts and souls of those with mental illnesses. Lord, You have left Your gift of peace of mind with them so their hearts will not be afraid. Although they may be pressed on every side by troubles, they will not be crushed and broken. Father, we confess that they will lie down without fear and enjoy pleasant dreams.

***Find God's promises concerning peace and begin to declare them over those people who you know are stressed and overburdened by life:***

Loving Father, we ask You to replace their sadness with joy, defeat with victory, and fatigue with praise. Help those who feel depressed or sad to not focus on their circumstances, but rather focus on Your blessings in their lives. Holy Spirit, we ask that You strengthen and renew their innermost being.
