Windsor Village Church Family Global Missions Year End Report 2022

Last year, Global Missions assisted in packing a 40 ft container of books which was a part of the Windsor Village Church Family Promise of Giving donations. These donations were shipped directly to VKBC Kenya (Velosia Kingdom Builder Center) to be distributed and shared with other organizations around Kenya, such as schools and colleges.

In 2022, seven missionaries traveled to VKBC Kenya and worked with the children and the community building relationships with local churches and hospitals. Our missionaries and nurses worked in the local hospital attending to more than 150 patients and they also donated medicine worth more than \$1500.

VKBC- Kenya (Velosia Kingdom Builder Center) has 54 orphan children under the care of members of the Windsor Village Church Family. The center provides shelter, food, clothes, and education for orphan children from the age of zero to 22 years.

VKBC Breakdown of Children:

- 5 children are in Universities
- 4 in college
- 5 in high school
- 3 in grade 8 (next year will be in high school)
- 4 in the rescue program, but they still go to school near VKBC
- 13 in grades 1st 7th
- 4 in kindergarten
- 12 are under 4 years old and are learning with our staff within VKBC
- 4 are under 1 year old

VKBC is the permanent home for these children until they can be able to achieve their goals in life. We have three who are working and two girls who will be married after they have finished college. All of these children know VKBC as their home, we serve as their father and mother to them. We have more than 200 identified orphaned children in need of support outside the VKBC that are over 7 years old. Your donations support paying for school fees, books, and uniforms.

VKBC has transformed the area with clean water, and a mobile clinic through the funds donated from the Windsor Village Church Family.

In 2022, our missionaries who visited Kenya brought bags full of your donation of new and gently used clothes, and school supplies, to over 3,000 students in different areas of Kenya.

We were able to complete Phase 3 of VKBC, and those missionaries who visited were able to paint. At VKBC we have a library, we offer sewing classes, a computer room, and a study hall for after-school homework. We are in the process of building a school, which will have five classes and a lounge for the staff. Designed to start on Feb 2023.

VKBC has a garden, with cows, sheep, and chickens, where our children practice different scales on the weekend and during spring breaks. This helped VKBC to lower the budget, which is over \$68,000.

Every need at VKBC is met with our church members donating through a VKBC-designated account.

Our Program Mission:

- Educating the community
- Children rescue from abandonment
- Girls with early pregnancy
- Mobile clinic with the help of local doctors
- Building two-bedroom houses for needy families, which cost approximately \$3,800 funded by individuals. We have built six houses and beneficiaries are enjoying their new life in the comfort of their new home.

Global Missions will continue to train missionaries to serve abroad in 2023 to continue the mission work. Thank you very much for your continued support through your donations.
